



HOOP DREAMS NATION PARTICIPANT CODE OF CONDUCT

1. I will not berate the officials or "trash talk" to my opponent, nor allow my players or spectators to berate the officials or "trash talk."
2. I will not use profanity, or engage in verbal or physical threats or abuse at any time, nor allow my players or spectators to do so.
3. I will encourage and display good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, contest administrators, spectators, and officials at every game.
4. I will place the emotional and physical well being and development of my players & opponents ahead of my personal desire to win, and will encourage my players and spectators to do the same.
5. I will treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, gender, creed or ability, and will ensure that my players and spectators do the same.
6. I will demand a sports environment that is free from drugs, tobacco, alcohol, and violence and will refrain from their use at all Hoop Dreams Nation's events.
7. I will remember that youth sports are intended to be FUN and that winning and losing are part of everyone's experience, while encouraging players and spectators to do the same.
8. I will express my concerns through the proper channels respectfully, & will encourage parents & spectators of my team to speak with me about concerns in a respectful manner, rather than addressing officials or event staff.
9. I will respect the volunteers and staff that are assisting with the conduct of these events, and ensure that players and spectators do the same.
10. I will respect & adhere to the Colorado High School Athletic Association (CHSAA) and HDN rules governing eligibility and competition.

Suspensions and/or bans will be determined and evaluated case-by-case based on the nature of the violation and/or past history of violations. Hoop Dreams Nation reserves the right to remove, suspend, or ban any person from an event who violates their Code of Conduct or any of the governing rules and regulations of the National Alliance of Youth Sports or the Positive Coaching Alliance with or without a warning. If a parent is ejected from an event, they are required to take their child with them. Coaches, players, and spectators who violate these expectations must take immediate action to address and correct the inappropriate behavior, or face removal of themselves, their player(s), and/or their team from current and/or future events.
